CONTACT ACADEMY

Applicants should begin their application process with the Academy(ies) they are interested in attending during their Junior year of high school.

STEP 2

APPLY FOR A NOMINATION FROM SENATOR BRAUN

Beginning in March, applicants may apply for a nomination from Senator Braun. All necessary information and documentation may be submitted through the Senator's website: **braun.senate.gov/academy-nominations**.



INTERVIEW WITH SERVICE ACADEMY BOARD

Senator Braun's Service Academy Board will review all the applications, select which applicants to conduct in-person interviews with and then finally submit their recommendations to Senator Braun concerning which applicants should receive a nomination.

Nominations are very limited for each member and highly competitive so applying to both Senators and your Member of Congress can greatly increase the chance of receiving a nomination.

Academy Nomination Timeline

Senator Braun's nominations process opens each year in **early March** and applications must be completed by **early October**. The Nominations Board will meet to interview with selected applicants in **November** and nominations will be issued at their advice in **December**.

Your finished application should include:

- Completed questionnaire
- Submission of required documents:
 - 3 letters of recommendation
 - Official Academic Transcripts (including class rank)
 - Official SAT and/or ACT scores
 - Essay (300 word max) explaining why you wish to attend the academy
 - Recent photo
 - Resume of extracurricular activities
